The Quinnipiac University volleyball team concludes the 2009 campaign Sunday, when it plays host to Saint Francis (Pa.) at 1 p.m. The Bobcats look to close the season on a winning note, while the Red Flash plays the third match in a three-day span. Saint Francis fell at FDU Friday night, before playing Saturday afternoon at Sacred Heart.

## Senior Send-off

The Bobcats will honor their seniors, Kristen Corinaldesi and Erin Overdevest, prior to Sunday's match. Corinaldesi has been a member of the team for the past three years, while Overdevest is completing her fifth season.

## Scouting the Saint Francis (Pa.) Red Flash

The Red Flash (7-22, 4-9 NEC) is led by Shirley Miller, who leads the team in kills (300) and digs (291). Rikki Myers has controlled the offense with 750 assists, while Lauren Wingard and Elizabeth Williams lead the defense with 48 and 46 blocks, respectively. Wingard also has a team-high 28 service aces.

Logan Riker leads the Bobcats with 381 digs, while Kelby Carey has a team-high 293 kills.

## **Double-Double Dynamo**

Kelby Carey has compiled 11 double-doubles this season, including seven in her last 11 matches and 10 in her last 16 matches.

## **Double-Double Duo**

Both Kelby Carey and Chelsey Pachoud compiled double-doubles in the Bobcats Oct. 29 match at Sacred Heart. Carey had 10 kills and 13 digs in compiling her ninth double-double of the season, while Pachoud's second double-double consisted of 11 kills and 12 digs.

## **Flourishing In Five**

The Bobcats have gone 2-1 in five-set matches this season, with the two victories coming within five days of each other. Quinnipiac defeated St. Francis (N.Y.) on Oct. 9 before outlasting Holy Cross on Oct. 13. Most recently, the Bobcats fell at Fairleigh Dickinson, Nov. 6.

## **Career Day at the Genovesi Center**

A pair of Bobcats set new career highs at St. Francis (N.Y.) on Oct. 9. Kelby Carey smashed her previous career-high of 16 kills with 24 against the Terriers, while Kayla Lawler eclipsed her previous high of 41 assists with 53 against St. Francis.

## **Missed It By That Much**

Kayla Lawler narrowly missed compiling what would've been her first career triple-double, posting a line of nine kills, 53 assists and 12 digs at St. Francis (N.Y.) on Oct. 9. The kill and assist figures were both career highs for the sophomore setter.

## **Double-Double Week Week**

Kelby Carey compiled three consecutive double-doubles from Sept. 23-26. She started the streak with 11 kills and 16 digs at Central Connecticut on Sept. 23. She then compiled 12 kills and 12 digs, on the morning Sept. 26 at Yale, before posting a 15-kill, 14-dig performance that evening against CCSU.

## **Reaching New Heights**

Several Quinnipiac student-athletes established season highs in the Bobcats' 3-0 sweep of St. Francis (N.Y.) on Sept. 20. Kelby Carey eclipsed her prior season-and-career-high with 16 kills, while Alyssa Naylor hit a season-best .588. Kayla Lawler established a new season-high with 40 assists, while Chelsey Pachoud had a season-best 12 kills to go along with 11 digs to compile her first career double-double.

## **Riker Rakes In All-Tournament Honors**

Freshman Logan Riker earned St. John's Classic All-Tournament Team recognition in her first weekend as a collegiate volleyball player after registering a team-high 34 digs on the weekend. Included in the feat was a 16-dig performance in the season-opener against Fordham.

## **Carey-ing The Load**

Sophomore Kelby Carey had a team-high 30 kills during the St. John's Classic, including a career-high 14 against Fordham.

## **Pachoud Packs A Punch**

Freshman Chelsey Pachoud compiled 22 kills (2nd-team) and 29 digs (2nd-team) at the St. John's Classic. She finished the weekend with a pair of double-digit dig efforts.

## **Bobcats Boast Academic Success**

The Bobcats were honored by the Northeast Conference and the American Volleyball Coaches Association last season after compiling a 3.61 team grade-point average. The Bobcats' GPA was tops in the NEC, while the AVCA honored QU with its Team Academic Award, given annually to teams that compile at least a 3.3 GPA on a 4.0 scale, for the third consecutive year.

## **Bobcats Bring Back Six**

The Bobcats return six letter winners this season. Leading the group is graduate student Erin Overde-vest, who missed last season due to injury. Senior Kristen Corinaldesi returns to the Bobcats after serving in a reserve capacity last season. Sophomores Stephanie Biediger, Kelby Carey, Kayla Lawler and Alyssa Naylor all started for the Bobcats in 2008, giving Quinnipiac an experienced returning core of players.

Robin Lamott Sparks enters her third season at Quinnipiac as the head women's volleyball coach. Sparks came to Quinnipiac, her first collegiate position, after spending three seasons as the head varsity volleyball coach at Troy High School in Troy, N.Y.


Sparks attended the 2009 NCAA Women's Coaches Academy (WCA) in Atlanta, Ga. The WCA is designed to give coaches the opportunity to understand their expanding role as a coach, along with perspectives and skills to help them make the most of their situation. In the company and understanding of other coaches, they have the opportunity to talk and listen with others to gain support and learn new tools and strategies. While at Troy, Sparks rebuilt the girl's volleyball program, advancing to the sectionals for the first time in over a decade. For her efforts, Sparks was given the Albany Times Union Volleyball Coach of the Year award. During her time at Troy, the team was named as a New York State Scholar Athlete team for all three years during Sparks' tenure.

In 2005, Troy finished with their first winning record in 10 years, 13-5, while also winning the Big Ten Conference championship with an 11-1 conference mark. Sparks' team featured the conference player of the year while also turning out five all-conference players. Among Troy's 11 wins that season was a win over Schenectady High School, snapping their 49-game conference win streak. That season, Sparks was chosen as the Big Ten head coach for the Exceptional Senior Game.

In 2006, Sparks once again led Troy to a winning record, posting a 14-5 overall mark while finishing 9-3 in the conference. Troy landed four more players on the all-conference team and finished the year as the Big Ten Conference runner-up.

While at Troy, Sparks was involved in the USA Volleyball Youth and Junior Division programs, serving on the USA Volleyball Elite Athlete Development Commission from 2003 to 2007. Sparks has also served on the USA Volleyball High Performance coaching staff, as well as serving as a court coach and evaluator at the USA Volleyball National High Performance tryouts.

In 2000, Sparks was named as the Junior Volleyball Director for the Iroquois Empire Region of USA Volleyball, overseeing over 30 clubs in the eastern part of New York. The various initiatives put forth by Sparks in this role included the launching of the Iroquois Empire Region high performance program for athletes, a two-day regional championship format, the Juniors' board of operations and a fellowship program to promote training of officials, scorekeepers and overall sportsmanship. Sparks was also a founding board member and co-director of the North Country Volleyball Association. She holds USA Volleyball CAP-I and CAP-II certifications and a New York State Coaching License. She is also certified as a USA Volleyball IMPACT instructor and a member of the American Volleyball Coaches Association. Sparks is also a member of the Professional Association of Volleyball Officials (PAVO) and has officiated on the NCAA Division I levels for several conferences including the America East, Metro-Atlantic Area, Patriot League, Ivy League, Colonial Athletic Association, Northeast and the BIG EAST, as well as several Division II, III and junior colleges.



Before she began coaching, Sparks was the director of internships and special projects at the University of Albany's Rockefeller College of Public Affairs and Policy in the Office of Career and Alumni Services. She has also worked for Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in the Office of Marketing and Media Relations and was responsible for all presidential communications including speechwriting and talking points.

Prior to moving to New York in 2000, Sparks worked for the Federal Bureau of Investigation (F.B.I.) in Washington, D.C. as a congressional affairs specialist and budget analyst. She also worked in the offices of Congresswoman Lynn Woolsey and U.S. Senator Dianne Feinstein. In addition, she held positions with the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the House Appropriations Committee.

Sparks graduated magna cum laude from Ball State University's College of Arts and Science with a bachelor's of arts in history from the University's Honors College in 1989. She later received her master's of public administration in 1991 from Syracuse University's Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs. Lamott Sparks is currently married. Her husband Ron, and her two stepdaughters, Simone, Shevaun and daughter Sydney, currently live in Hamden, Conn.
